NOTE: Start your application early. You will need your Letter of Approval before you can begin your project. The Architecture Committee that reviews your project generally meets once each month, and the FHGC office requires some time for associated administrative functions.

Please submit this application form (pages 1 and 2) together with your photos and supporting documents to the Forest Hills Gardens Office. You may add additional pages to support/explain your project using the guidelines on the following pages.

Do not make any purchases, sign any contracts, or begin installation until you have your official Letter of Approval from FHGC.

Once you have your FHGC Letter of Approval and permit, you may begin your project. Share your Letter of Approval with your contractor so he may understand the full scope of your project and any specific requirements. Your contractor's contract should adhere to the conditions stipulated in your Letter of Approval.

Post your FHGC Permit in a prominent location while work is underway.

Goal

Replace windows to match the *original* window style inherent to the home's architecture.

Standards

Insert and Full Rip Out Windows

- 1. **Insert** replacement windows require the removal of only the existing sashes while retaining the original perimeter wood frame. The replacement "insert" window containing a new frame with sashes will be installed within the original wood frame. This method has the benefit of retaining the existing mullions (the wood member between two adjacent windows) and interior and exterior moldings, while requiring the least amount of modification to the home.
- 2. **Full rip out** replacement windows require the entire removal of the frame, sashes, moldings and mullions. This option is usually selected when the original window frame is irreparably damaged and not cost effective to repair. Note: This option will require duplicating the original window configuration.
- 3. Consult with your contractor and indicate the choice of window configuration on page 1 of your application.

Submit the Following Information with Your Application

- 1. Photograph or sketch of each side of the home with each window planned for replacement marked with a unique identifying number.
- 2. Provide manufacturer specifications of each window marked with the matching unique identifying number from the marked photograph or sketch.
- 3. Verify the specifications includes manufacturer name, window series, style (insert or full rip out), construction (wood or wood with aluminum cladding), dimensions, color, muntin profile and size, and number of divided lites per sash (see example of a specification below).
- 4. Refer to the color palette for your home to determine the paint or clad color for your windows. If you do not have a color palette you may obtain one from the FHGC office. Do not copy your neighbor's color or match the color you currently have as these may be inaccurate.


Example of Exterior Paint Palette
